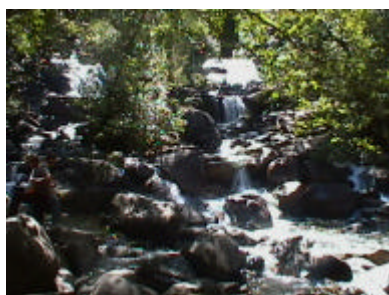

Day 7 - Yellowhead Highway

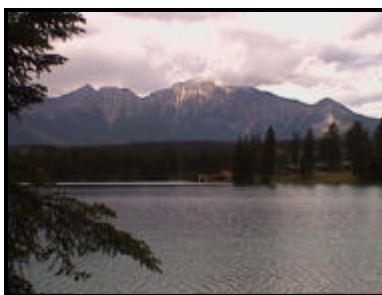
Did you ever take a jetboat ride on a glacier lake whose water temperature was just above freezing. WE did and it was INVIGORATING!

Jasper, Alberta - Utopia on Earth!

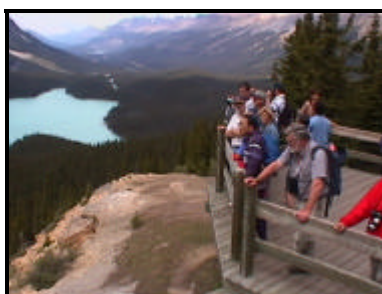
Day 9 - On the Road to Lake Louise...
